Directions to Blendon Woods Metro Park: From I-270, take State Route 161 Expressway (exit #30B) east toward New Albany onto E. Dublin-Granville Road. Go 1.6 miles, then take the Little Turtle Way exit and turn right. Then turn right immediately onto Old State Route 161. Blendon Woods entrance is 1/2 mile on left. Drive back to Hickory Grove Shelter, taking a left at the “Y” in the road. Go past the Nature Center and look for the posted Hickory Grove signs.
